Notice of Series

(Version 3 – dated 19 February 2025 - highlighted in yellow – NoS 2.3 has been deleted, NoS 4.1, 5.1 & 6.1(b) has been amended)

The Royal Cape Performance Circuit – Cape 31 (the Series) comprises the eight Events listed below, the first starting on 19 October 2024 and the last finishing on 8 March 2025. The Organizing Authority (OA) is the SA Cape 31 Class Owners Association.

1. The Events and dates

Event 1: Royal Cape Performance Circuit Event #1, 19 - 20 October 2024, Royal Cape Yacht Club, Cape Town

Event 2: Royal Cape Performance Circuit Event #2, 16 - 17 November 2024, Royal Cape Yacht Club, Cape Town

Event 3: Cape Performance Cup, 30 November - 1 December 2024, Royal Cape Yacht Club, Cape Town

Event 4: Tip of Africa Cup, 6 - 8 December 2024, V&A Waterfront, Cape Town

Event 5: Royal Cape Performance Circuit Race Day #1, 8 February 2025, Royal Cape Yacht Club, Cape Town

Event 6: Cape 31 Waterfront Event, 21 - 23 February 2025, V&A Waterfront, Cape Town

Event 7: Mykonos Regatta, 28 February - 1 March 2025, Mykonos Resort, Langebaan

Event 8: Yacht Port Event, 7 - 8 March 2025, Yacht Port, Saldana

2. Rules

2.1 The Series will be governed by the rules as defined in the Racing Rules of Sailing.

2.2 For each event, the Event Notices of Race and the Event Sailing Instructions will apply. These may be found on the SA Cape 31 [website](#) (Events 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, & 8) or the RCYC [website](#) (Event 7).

3. Communication

Information about the Series and notices to competitors will be posted on the Official Notice Board (ONB) ([click here](#)).

4. Eligibility

4.1 The Series is open to all Cape 31s racing in compliance with the **South African Cape 31 Class Rules** [<https://sa.cape31.com/class-rules/>] and the provisions of this Notice of Series.

4.2 The person-in-charge and other crew members need not be the same for each Event in the Series.

5. Entry

5.1 For SA boats their entry for Events 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6 & 8 are covered by their **South African Cape 31 Association** memberships fees. The standard Mykonos Offshore Regatta entry fees will apply.

6. Sail limitations

6.1 Boats shall register, and have on board throughout the Series, the following sails:

- (a) One mainsail
- (b) One 'All Purpose Jib' (ie any jib within South African Cape 31 Class Rules)
- (c) One 'heavy-weather' jib (complying with the **dimensions** in OSR 4.27.3.)
- (d) Two or three spinnakers

6.2 A registered sail may only be replaced with the prior written permission of the OA.

7. Scoring and results

7.1 A boat's Event score will be her finishing place in that event.

7.2 A boat's overall Royal Cape Performance Circuit – Cape 31 series score will be the total of her Event scores.

7.2.1 After 3 or more events have been completed a boats series score will be the total of her Event scores excluding her worst score.

7.3 A boat that did not participate in an Event shall be scored one point more than the Event score of the boat finishing last in that Event.

7.4 The boat with the lowest Series score wins and others shall be ranked accordingly.

7.5 Series score tie(s): A Royal Cape Performance Circuit overall score tie will be broken by the event score of the final event (changes RRS A8).

9.1 Competitors and support teams participate in the Series entirely at their own risk. They are reminded of the provisions of RRS 3, Decision to Race.
